We recently updated the Catalogue with:

New study

We have added the <u>Edinburgh Study of Youth</u>
<u>Transitions and Crime</u> which follows more than 4,000 youth over the past 20+ years. Findings from this study have shed light on youth offending and the impact of interventions.

New information page

We have released the <u>personality and</u> <u>temperament page</u> which includes our definitions of these two topics along with some of the measures that have been used by the studies on the Catalogue to measure them.

Measures in Harmony

A team led by Dr Bettina Moltrecht (UCL) and Dr Eoin McElroy (Ulster University) have developed **Harmony**, an online tool that uses natural language processing to quantitatively assess the similarity of questionnaire items – allowing researchers to identify subsets of 'harmonizable' questions that can be used to make direct comparisons or pool data across studies. Harmony will become interoperable with the Catalogue, and is freely available at **harmonydata.org**.
