- The <u>COVID Social Mobility & Opportunities</u> <u>study (COSMO)</u>, a national cohort study of more than 12,000 young people from across England during COVID.
- The <u>Social and Economic</u> <u>Predictors of the Severe</u> <u>Mental Disorders Study</u> <u>(SEP-MD)</u>, the first linked cohort study featured on the Catalogue.
